

University of Scouting Poster Contest

100th Anniversary of Scouting

Theme: 100_____of Scouting

(Artist fills in the blank – example: years, things I take to camp; adventures, etc)

Poster size: Minimum is 1/4 poster size sheet – Maximum full sheet

Medium is artist's choice

Process:

1. Every Unit is invited to participate
 - a. Each unit holds their own poster contest
 - b. selects one winners by category
 - c. Sends winners to District Contest
 - d. Displays remaining posters around community
 - i. To be completed by Feb 1 – posters in community by Scout Week
2. District Holds contest –
 - a. preferable at February District Roundtables
 - b. District Contest managed by U of S Recruitment Representatives
 - c. One winner is selected in each category and sent on to the U of S in March
 - d. Posters are on display at U of S
 - e. Winners are selected and announced at the end of the day
 - f. All winning posters will be displayed around Scout Shops
 - g. Intent is to eventually return to boy/venture/adult
3. Categories/Prizes are a free trip to:
 - a. Tigers – Parent & Pal Weekend
 - b. Wolf Scouts – Parent & Pal Weekend
 - c. Bear Scouts – Day Camp
 - d. Webelos I & II - Webelos Resident Camp
 - e. Boy Scouts (prior to 13th birthday) – 1 week at Summer Camp
 - f. Boy Scouts (13th birthday plus) – 1 week at NYLT (or summer camp if have attended NYLT)
 - g. Venturers – dinner & a movie for you and 3 friends
 - h. Adult – appropriate 100th book
